

In May 1981, the Coast Guard officially departed the Lighthouse, though it continues to manage the automated light tower from Oswego. Tibbetts Point boasts the only operational Fresnel Lens on Lake Ontario.



Some of my specialties include crostata- also know as a Rustic Tart which is a pastry dough filled with a fresh fruit filling. A double layer carrot cake with cream cheese frosting, raspberry- white chocolate coconut bread, hazelnut filled cookies, & chocolate peanut butter cake. Make a request!

Hello! I am Lainie Taylor, the name behind Bramblebee Honey. Beekeeping has been learning process for nearly nine years. Long about 2020 I started getting it right, when I harvested my first honey, from then on I harvest between 100-300 lbs of honey a year. Each year there are between four and six healthy hives that live in an apple orchard and wild raspberry bramble. Yup, that's where the name bramblebee honey came from. All the hives are maintained by me, I harvest the honey, spin and jar it. A lot of work and time goes into one jar of honey.

All of my baked goods include fresh raw honey, some of which is creamed honey- a different color with a higher sugar content.

DISCOVER CAPE VINCENT

Located in a most picturesque place, where the lake and the river meet, Cape Vincent is a charming village at the mouth of the St. Lawrence River, where

European settlers began arriving in Cape Vincent in 1615, five years before the historic landing of the Mayflower in Plymouth. The French explorer Samuel de Champlain, the founder of Quebec City, reached Lake Ontario near Kingston, Canada, in 1615. French priests Father Chaumonoit and Father Dablon were in the Cape Vincent area as missionaries to the Onondaga natives in 1655. English and French traders established forts and trading posts along the great lakes in an effort to monopolize trade and extend their influence with Native American nations.

In the 1770s English settlers began moving west from New England looking for game, timber and land suitable for farming. The proximity of the great lakes and the St. Lawrence river facilitated communication, commerce and defense. In 1788 land speculators →

Alexander Macomb and William Constable purchased a large tract of land in Northern New York, which was subsequently bought by Jacques LeRay de Chaumont, a Frenchman with US citizenship. This land extended from what is today Fort Drum to Alexandria Bay and included Cape Vincent and Chaumont Bay. The involvement of LeRay attracted a number of his wealthy aristocratic countrymen seeking to flee the turmoil of the French Revolution. These French expatriates included Comte Pierre Francois Real, Field Marshall Grouchy and General Rolland, all of whom intended to free Napoleon Bonaparte from his exile in the island of St. Helena and bring him to where Cape Vincent is today. The first organized settlement of what would become the village of Cape Vincent was commissioned by LeRay in 1809 and named after his son Vincent. A ferry service across the St Lawrence river between Cape Vincent and Wolfe Island, Canada, was established as early as 1807.

By 1900, Cape Vincent was a "bustling town." There were seven grocery stores, three meat markets, a bakery, two drug stores, five hotels, a paint

and wallpaper store, a bookstore, a village newspaper, two clothing stores, a hardware store and a jewelry store. Business included lumbering, ice harvesting, seed raising, boat builders, hay dealers, photographers, milliners, tailors, draymen and several livery stables.

Over the years, many historical buildings and landmarks were added to the unique architectural landscape of Cape Vincent. The **Tibbets Point Lighthouse**, erected in 1826 to guide ships traveling from Lake Ontario into the St Lawrence River, is still in use today as an active aid to navigation. The grounds and gift shop are open to the public for visitation.

On Real Street, towards the river, is the **Cape Vincent Community Library**, opened to the public in 1968 and built over the original site of the Cup and Saucer house originally built in 1818 as a possible refuge for Napoleon Bonaparte. While this house was destroyed by a fire in 1867, the foundations of the original building are part of the current library building.

The Community House, located on Market Street and built in the early

1800s, was eventually donated to the village of Cape Vincent as a Community Building in 1931. In 1969 it was opened as the first Museum for the village. Subsequently, the **Cape Vincent Historical Museum** has relocated to a stone structure located on North James Street, which had been previously used as barracks to house soldiers during the war of 1812. Today, besides the museum, this historic stone building houses a Tourist Information and Visitor's Center as well.

In 1968 local residents inaugurated a French Festival day, an annual affair held on the second Saturday in July near Bastille Day to celebrate Cape Vincent's French origins and heritage. This event has grown each year since its foundation, bringing thousands of visitors to Cape Vincent annually for the celebration, which consists of French booths, a variety of vendors, exhibits, costumes, French pastries, a parade, band concerts and a fireworks display in the evening.

As you travel through Cape Vincent, enjoy the unique combination of the tranquility of the village, the friendliness of its inhabitants and the beauty of its natural surroundings. Those of us who make our home in the Cape Vincent area are very proud of where we live and wish to welcome you to come and appreciate this wonderful place.
