

THE WRITER'S CORNER

Found by a Rocket

No, I'm not talking about making a new dive site by sinking a ship with a rocket. I am talking about a lost shipwreck that was found by a rocket.

This article began while researching popular wreck sites for our book "Dive the Thousand Islands". We started at Tibbetts Point and worked our way down River, recording many popular dive sites.

The Arizona is located in Canadian waters, southwest of the Horne Ferry Landing on the south shore of Wolfe Island, near red buoy R244. This wooden propeller steam barge, launched in 1868, was 184 feet long with a 33-foot beam. After delivering coal to Brockville, Ontario, on December 6, 1922, the Arizona caught fire on the morning of December 7th at the Cape Vincent Break Wall and sank at her moorings.

In 1923, the hull was raised, fitted with pontoons, and then intentionally re-sunk outside navigation channels using 200 pounds of dynamite. Consequently, the wreck now rests in approximately 35 feet of water, surrounded by periwinkle shells. Visible remnants include a chain and winch at the bow, boilerplates at the stern, and the propeller and large rudder lying on the bottom behind the boiler.

The Arizona shipwreck was serendipitously discovered between 1962 and 1964 by sport scuba divers recovering experimental rockets launched by the Clarkson University Rocket Society.

The story of the discovery the shipwreck Arizona was told by lifetime Clayton resident Skip Couch, one of the first sport scuba divers in the Thousand Islands. Skip revealed that the Arizona was found by accident in the 1960s. He was part of a crew hired by Captain Gordon Hutchinson of Clayton to recover test rockets launched by the Clarkson Rocket Society from Tibbetts Point Road in Cape Vincent.

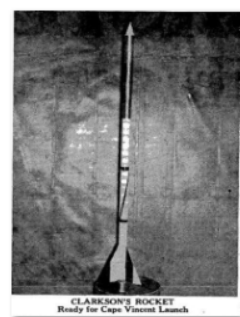
Further research confirmed Skip's story. In the early 1960s, Clarkson University student Tom Fitzgerald, a Cape Vincent resident and rocket enthusiast, established a launch pad called "Cape Carnival" on his family's property on Tibbetts Point Road. The Clarkson Rocket Society conducted various rocket tests there, with Captain Gordon Hutchinson and his divers, including Skip Couch, responsible for recovering the rockets from the river. Many of the rockets landed in Canadian waters off Wolfe Island.

An article from the Massena Observer on April 18, 1963, corroborates these activities, detailing planned rocket launches by the Clarkson Rocket Society. Some of these rockets were equipped with parachutes and transmitters. This article explicitly mentioned Captain Gordon C. Hutchinson as the professional skin diver hired for recovery.

During one rocket recovery operation, diver Skip Couch discovered a fallen rocket amidst the wreckage of what was then an unknown shipwreck. Over 40 years after its sinking, this wreck was identified as the Arizona.

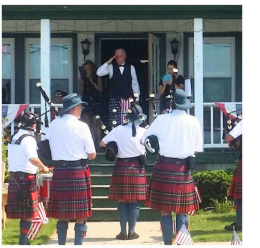
