



# Le Marché aux Trésors — Vintage Vendor Information

## 1. Fee & Schedule

- **Booth Fee:** \$100 per \$12' \times 12'\$ space.
- **Event Date:** Saturday, July 11, 2026.
- **Set-Up:** Saturday only, 7:00 a.m. – 9:00 a.m.
- **Sales Hours:** 9:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.
- **Teardown:** Absolutely no teardowns before 6:00 p.m. Early teardown may result in exclusion from future festivals.

## 2. Application, Approval & Payment

- **All-in-One Process:** Application and payment are consolidated into a single submission.
- **Committee Review:** All applications are reviewed by the Festival Committee to ensure they meet the criteria for vintage wares, antiques, and collectibles.
- **No Guarantee:** Submission does not guarantee acceptance. Acceptance in previous years does not guarantee approval for the current year.
- **Refund Policy:** If an application is declined, fees will be refunded less processing and administrative costs. Once approved, booth fees are non-refundable for weather, cancellations, or personal emergencies.

## 3. Requirements & Logistics

- **French Theme:** Vendors are strongly encouraged to decorate their booths and dress in a French-themed style to enhance the "Market of Treasures" atmosphere.
- **Mandatory Documentation:** \* Copy of NYS Certificate of Authority to Collect Sales Tax (must be displayed).
  - Certificate of Liability Insurance (minimum \$1,000,000) listing the Cape Vincent Chamber of Commerce and French Festival Committee as Additional Insured.
  - Photos of merchandise for review and promotional "Vendor Profiles".
- **Booth Setup:** \* Outdoor event, rain or shine.
  - Booths are located on the pavement; appropriate weights are required to secure tents.
  - Vendors must supply their own tables, chairs, and displays.

- Vehicles are not permitted in vendor spaces unless essential to the display.
- **Conduct:**
  - Vendors are responsible for all trash removal from their booth area.
  - Non-service animals are strictly prohibited.
  - Security is not provided; the Committee is not responsible for loss or damage.
