To our seasonal residents and visitors, welcome back, and bienvenue! We hope you enjoy everything our community has to offer. As we settle into the heart of summer and another busy boating season, on behalf of the Town Board and our employees; I would like to wish everyone a happy, healthy, and safe summer.

Let's talk a little bit about a topic that's been on everyone's mind, the Route 12E detour in Three Mile Bay. While it's certainly an inconvenience, it's a necessary one as NYSDOT replaces the culvert at Shaver Creek (a place many of us probably never knew existed until now!) For most travelers, County Route 8 (Millens Bay Road) remains the easiest and most reliable route. The Burnt Rock Road detour is intended primarily for local traffic and those accessing homes and businesses north of the closure, including Sally Port View, Huck & Finns, Shangri-La, and the Mud Bay area.

With increased traffic on these rural roads, please slow down, watch for farm equipment, cyclists, and wildlife, (the deer are out in large numbers) and help keep everyone safe. We have already had several close calls and the Jefferson County Sheriff's patrols have increased their presence. Thank you for your continued patience and cooperation.

Our Highway Department has been working hard maintaining roads, paving, and updating road calming measures, while also making progress at the future Club Street Waterfront Park. Last week they spent time removing old concrete debris from the site. It's exciting to see progress continuing on projects that will benefit our community for years to come.

This Independence Day is especially meaningful as our nation celebrates its 250th anniversary. Here in Cape Vincent, we're also proud of the French and Canadian heritage that helped shape our community. Which brings us to French Festival - just around the corner. With it comes one of the busiest and most enjoyable weekends of the year. Whether you're on the water, attending one of our many events, or simply relaxing along the St. Lawrence, have a safe, memorable summer and a wonderful Fourth of July!
