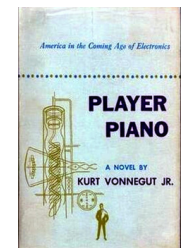
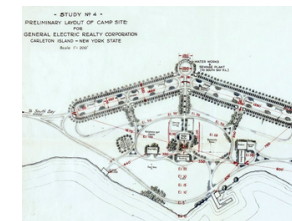
CARLETON ISLAND CONNECTIONS

GE's Plans for Carleton Island.. In the late 1920s and 1930, General Electric sought to replace its flood-prone retreat on Association Island in Lake Ontario by purchasing extensive land on Carleton Island. This land included the opulent Carleton Villa (Wyckoff estate). GE developed grand blueprints for a self-contained executive playground and summer retreat. The proposed development included three golf courses, a 500-seat theater and assembly hall, dining pavilions, dozens of cottages, athletic complexes, docks, and canal systems. However, the economic fallout of the Great Depression forced GE to scrap the ambitious project.

Kurt Vonnegut's Player Piano.. Drawing on his years working in public relations at GE's Schenectady plant, Kurt Vonnegut satirized GE's retreat culture in his 1952 debut novel, Player Piano.

In the novel, GE's real-life retreats inspired The Meadows, an exclusive island retreat on the St. Lawrence River. **The Meadows** serves as an annual conclave where the society's ruling class of engineers and technocrats gather for mandatory team-building exercises, athletic rivalries, drunken camaraderie, and choreographed corporate rituals. Vonnegut used this island setting as a critique of corporate conformity, illustrating how the elite used paternalistic spectacle to enforce blind loyalty to an automated, dehumanized social hierarchy.

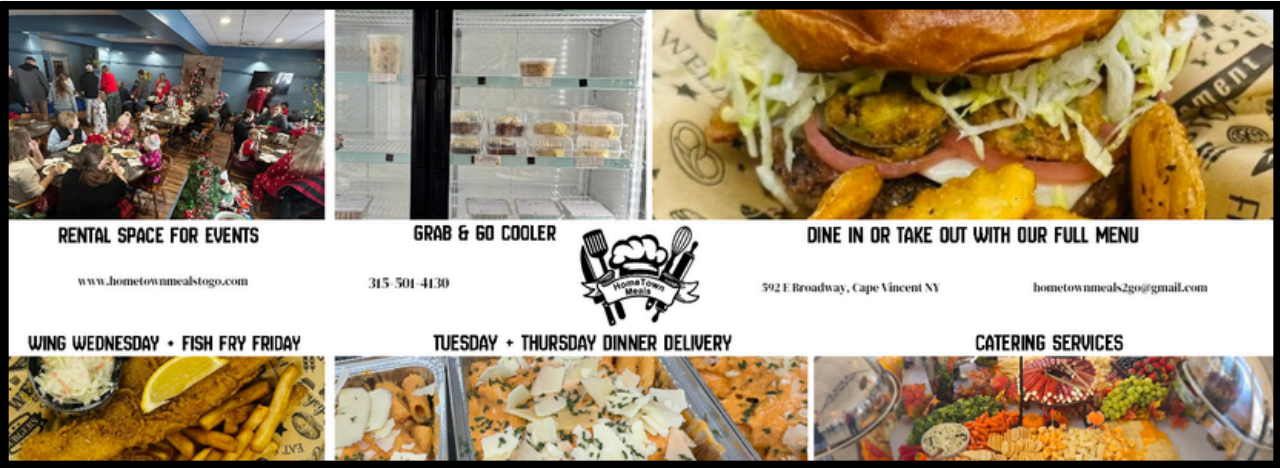

These efforts are helping build a strong foundation for increased tourism. Water District 7 is finally under construction! After a long wait, residents along Mud Bay and Lake Ontario in the Bedford Corners and Bates Road corridors are seeing this important project become a reality. Contractors are now laying the mainline pipes and expect to continue as weather permits, with water anticipated to begin flowing next fall. Thank you to everyone who has remained patient and supportive throughout the process, it's exciting to finally see progress!

Congresswoman Claudia Tenney recently included Cape Vincent on her tour of the area and took particular interest in Water District 7, especially since she has included financial support for the project in her 2027 discretionary budget. The Town Board will begin its 2027 budget discussions this month, meeting Wednesday evenings in September at 5:30 p.m. at the Town Office Building.

There is also exciting news along the waterfront. Water levels are the only thing standing in the way of Seaway Marine beginning work on the Club Street shoreline restoration and new docks. This project has been years in the making, but don't lose faith, we expect to see visible results this fall! Additionally, the upland park design for the shoreline along Club st. is complete and we expect it will go out for construction bids later this fall. Get ready for some long anticipated transformations along the waterfront!

Our Highway Department continues to keep Cape Vincent moving, maintaining our roads while also providing mutual assistance to neighboring communities. Behind the scenes, the crew is also preparing equipment for the seasons ahead. A special thank- you to Mike "the mechanic" Liebman, whose ability to repair and inspect our trucks in-house has saved the community thousands of dollars. Only the most extensive repairs now need to be sent out.

I also want to recognize our administrative team at the Town Offices. Their work may not always make headlines, but these are the people who provide the structure that keeps everything else functioning.
